Meeting Purpose: The purpose of Project Advisory Committee Meeting #4 was to review and discuss the Draft Transportation System Plan (TSP) update.

Discussion Topics:

General Discussion:

- Parking
 - Lessen parking requirements on private development in the downtown area
 - Include a review of parking code in development code
- ADA Facilities
 - Do we know which ADA facilities are being replaced by ODOT?
 - Compare list of ADA projects for Waldport with projects in the draft TSP.
 - See if we can piggyback other projects with new ramp projects.

Draft TSP Update:

- Pedestrian Plan
 - Crestline should be a higher priority Cedar to school (P10/P11)
 - SW from Cedar to Range, shared-use path from Range to School
 - Crestline Drive is a path, not a trail
- Transit Plan
 - Remove bus stop at library
- Roadway Plan
 - Move toward collectors, not major/minor collectors
 - Include cross reference to new plan in TSP

Parking

- Consider allowing parking on collector streets may want to talk about this with PC/CC
- Plan/code amendments
 - Up to city on how/when to adopt plan/code amendments
 - City will likely have separate hearing for implementing ordinances.

Action Items:

- Review parking code for potential changes
- Compare ODOT ADA projects for Waldport with projects in the draft TSP
- Increase priority of pedestrian facilities along Crestline from Cedar to school
- Identify pedestrian facilities along Crestline as sidewalks from Cedar to Range and as shared-use paths from Range to school
- Remove bus stop at library
- Remove "major" and "minor" from "collector"
