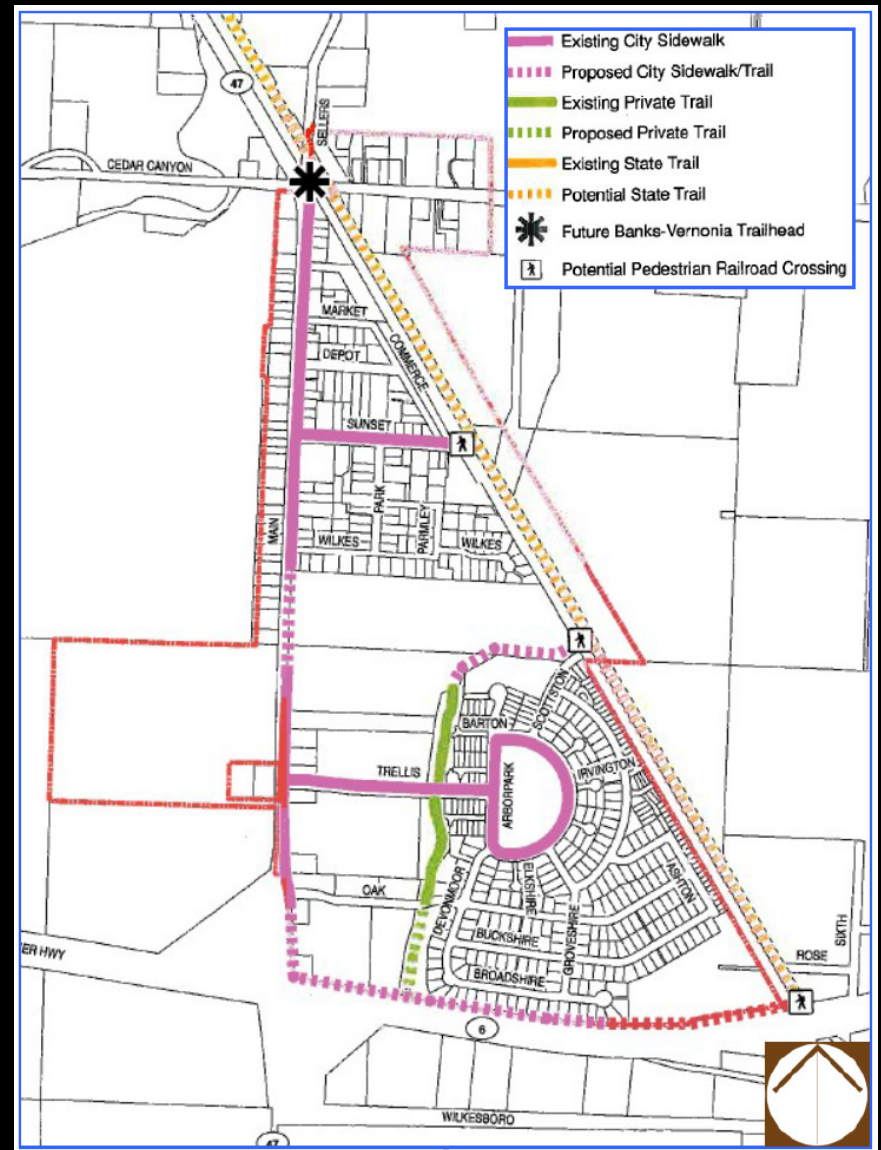

Regional Trails

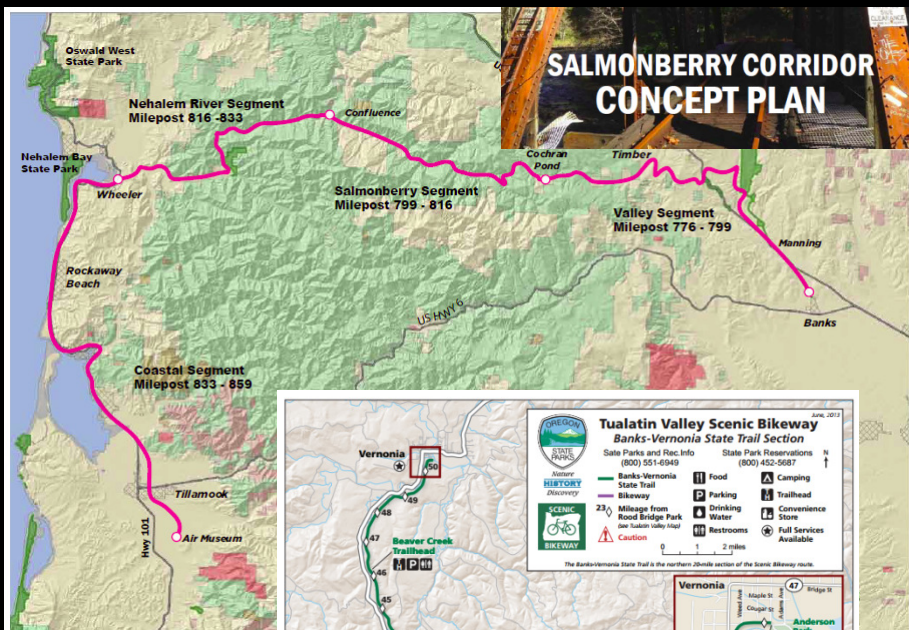
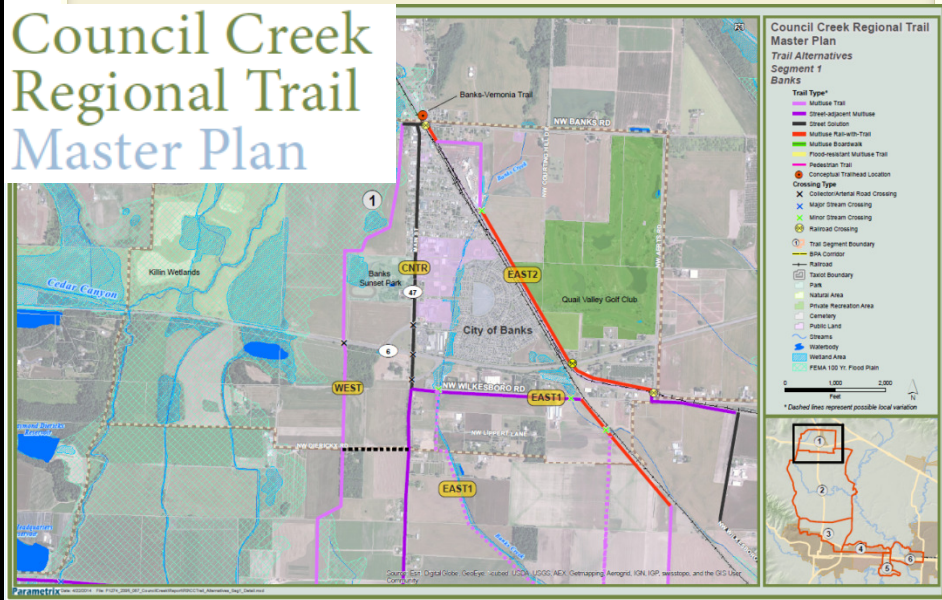
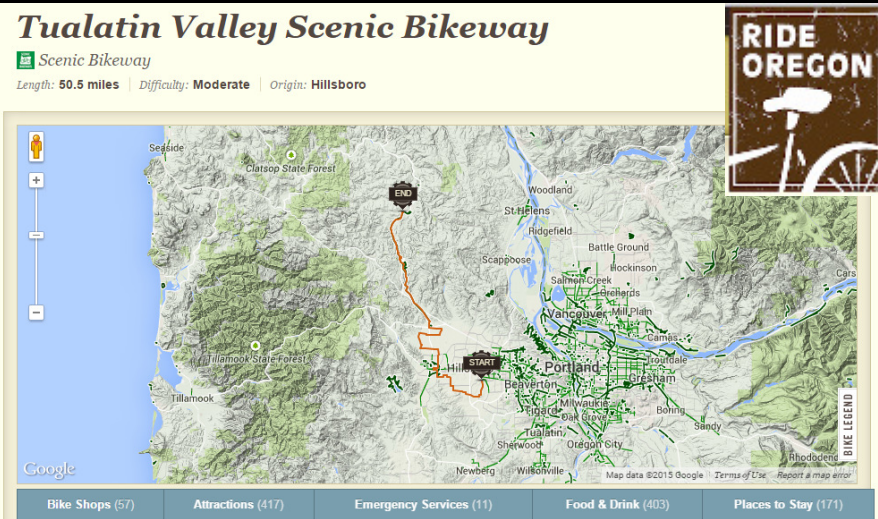
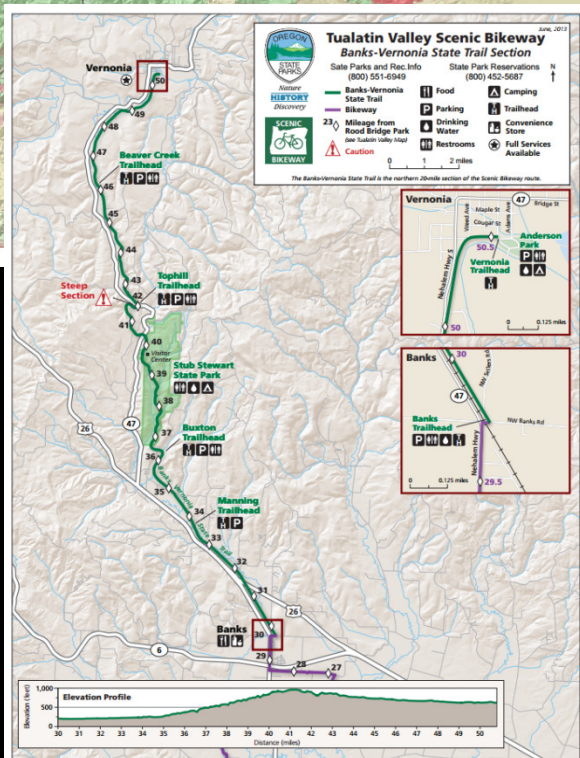


Figure 2: Salmonberry Corridor Overview Map

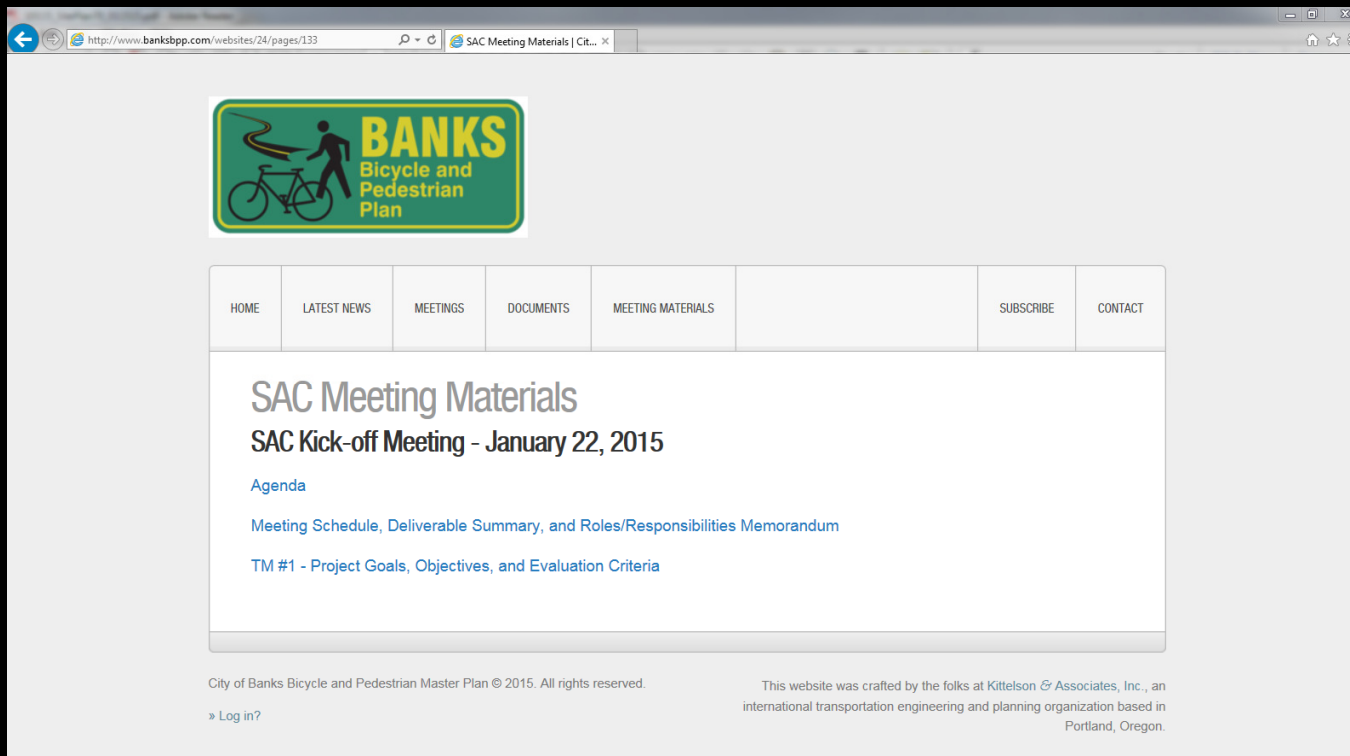

Project Evaluation Metrics

- **Goals** – provide **direction** for where the City would like to go. A goal is met when outcomes can be cited for that goal.
 - **Objectives** – provide a more detailed breakdown of goals with more **specific ends** the City desires to achieve.
 - **Evaluation criteria** – provide a **quantitative or qualitative tool** to assess progress towards the established objectives.

Project Evaluation Metrics

- Evaluation metrics will be used to:
 1. Evaluate the existing transportation system and identify areas for improvement; and
 2. Compare and select preferred projects to be included in the BPP.

Goals

- **Livability:** provide for a high quality of life by providing transportation options and considering community values and interests.
- **Safety and Health:** enable people to safely walk, run or cycle in and through the City.
- **Accessibility:** develop a bicycle and pedestrian system that is accessible for all ages, skill levels, and interests.
- **Financial Responsibility:** use resources efficiently and invest in infrastructure that will serve the City for years to come.
- **Economic Vitality:** encourage tourism and investment in the downtown core.

Objectives

- Intended to cover both current and potential users of the pedestrian and bicycle system.

- Cost
- Potential funding mechanisms
- Feasibility
- Connectivity
- Accessibility
- Destinations served by project
- Expected crash frequency/severity
- Multimodal level of service

Example Application

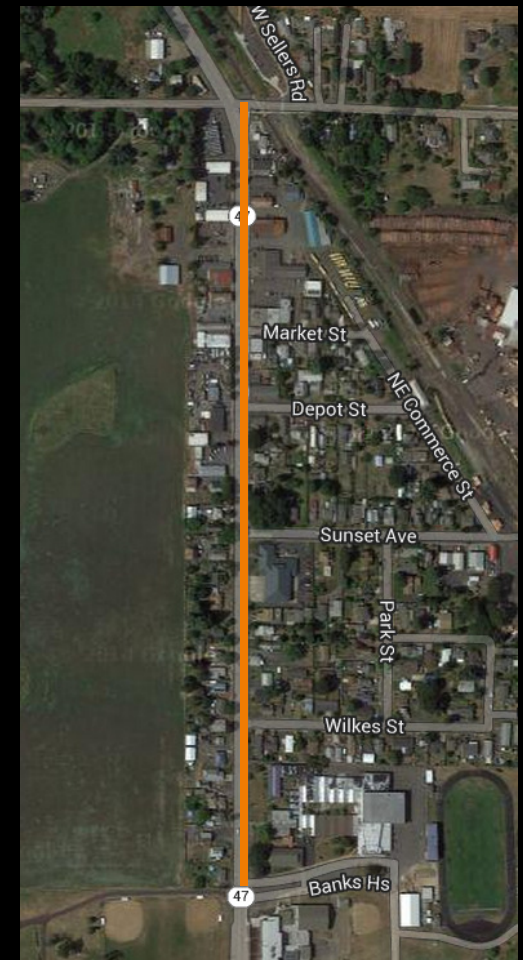
- Project: install a cycle track on Main Street between Banks High School and NW Banks Road

Cycle track: exclusive bike facility physically separated from motor traffic and distinct from sidewalk (NACTO)



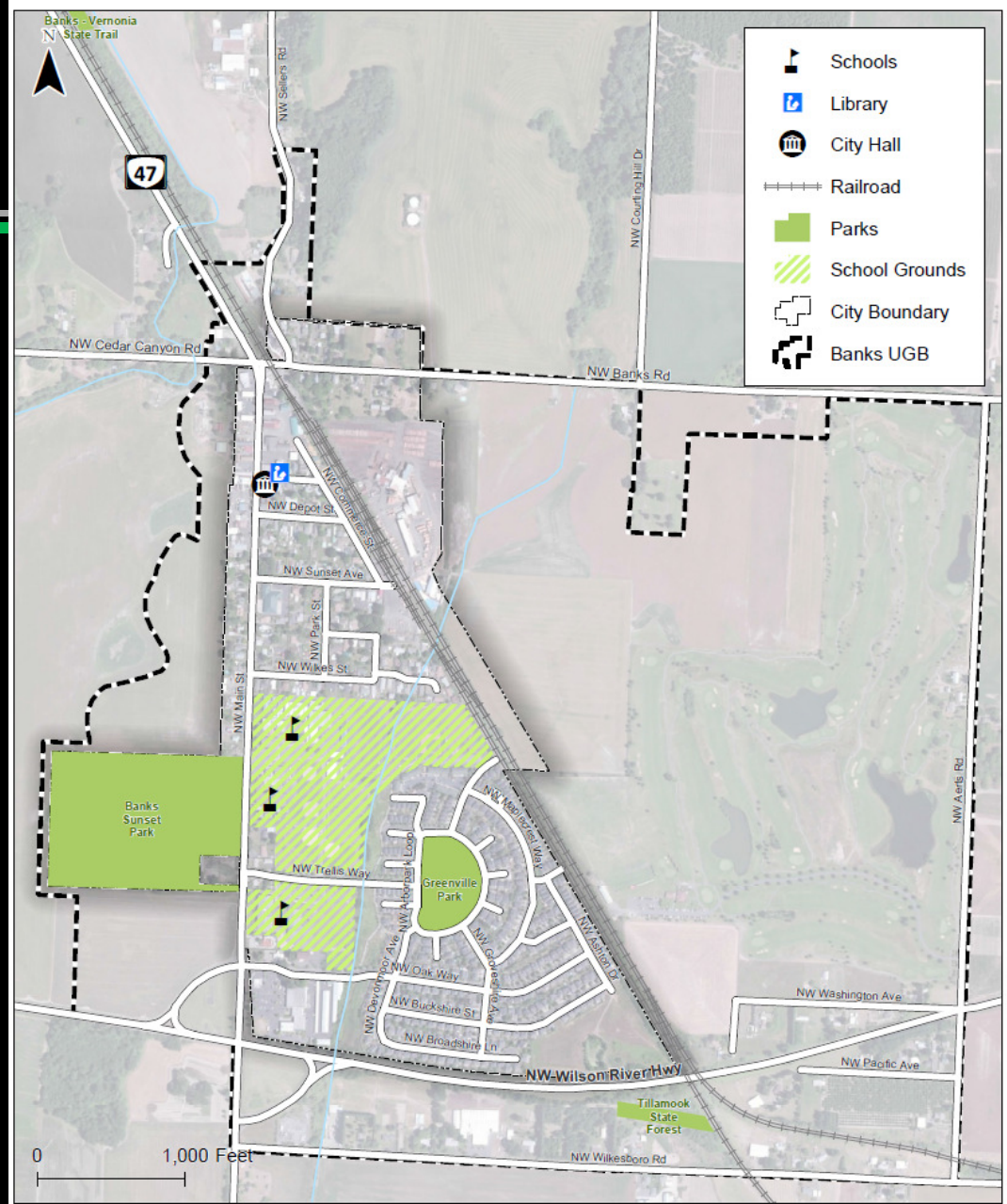
Example Application

Criteria	Application
Cost	Planning-level cost estimate
Potential funding mechanisms	i.e. grants, taxes, developers, bonds
Feasibility	Barriers – ownership, ROW, natural resources?
Connectivity	Fill a gap or create a new connection?
Accessibility	Enhance the system for all users?
Destinations served by project	Activity centers, schools, commercial areas, transit stops, etc.
Expected crash frequency/severity	Address an area with a crash history?
Multimodal level of service	Quality of facility for bikes and pedestrians
Populations served	What residents or tourists served?
