right-of-way standards when new development occurs; language from comp plan/code - prohibit new development on substandard streets (e.g., gravel roads) - would like to maintain this moving forward
- High crash locations at OR 42/Lookingglass and OR 42/Brockway; increase in ped-to-vehicle crashes at crosswalks since they've been installed
