- Other?




### Existing Conditions and Plans MI

  - Several goals/policies to expand access to rural bike/ped system and improve safety
- Deschutes National Forest Plans/Studies
  - Most trails located on federal/public forest land
  - Deschutes National Forest Alt. Transportation Study identifies needed corridor access/connectivity improvements
- OAR 660-034-0035 Park Uses on Ag. And Forest Land
