#### **Issue Identification**

- Project team reviewed local plans, conducted field reviews, collected data, and performed analysis to assess:
  - Existing land uses, businesses, and accesses
  - Existing facilities and operations for vehicles, pedestrian, bicyclists, and transit
  - Crash history of the corridor
  - Planned improvements and projected growth
  - Future operations on the corridor



#### **Issue Identification**

- Issues identified include:
  - Driveway spacing and conflicts
  - Pedestrian deficiencies
  - Top crash causes and locations
  - Opportunities for aesthetic treatments
  - Others
- Today's workshop will focus on identifying additional issues and improvements to consider

- > C1: Signal progression at 35 miles per hour
- > C2: Left-turn lanes at 9<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup>
- > C3: Gambell Street Underpass at 15th Avenue
- > C4: Gambell Parking Structure at 16th Avenue
- C5: Street dead-ending onto Gambell at 8<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and/or 14<sup>th</sup> Avenues
- > C6: Shared right of way with businesses
- C7: Snow removal strategies for roadway and sidewalks
- > C8: Pedestrian crossings



#### C1: Signal progression at 35 miles per hour


- + Consistent travel speeds through corridor
- Potential increase in delays at major cross streets





C2: Left-turn lanes at 9<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenues

- Right-of-way impacts
- Minimal improvement in operations





# C3: Gambell Street Underpass at 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue

- + Reduction in queues on Gambell
- Loss of access to businesses between 13<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>
- Increased queue lengths at Gambell St/Fireweed
- May not be compatible with eventual Seward-Glenn Highway connection

#### C4: Gambell Parking Structure at 16th Avenue

- + Additional parking for events at Chester Creek
   Sports Complex
- + Additional residential and commercial space
- Reduction in circulation demand for access from Ingra Street to Sports Complex
- High cost of implementation

**C5:** Street dead-ending onto Gambell at 8<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and/or 14<sup>th</sup> Avenues

- Improved street area for neighborhood use
- Maintenance costs
- Loss of grid-network connectivity
- Loss of parking to provide street dead end treatment





#### C6: Shared Right of Way with businesses

- + Improved operations
- + Enhanced safety for turning-vehicles





C7: Snow Removal Strategies for Roadway and Sidewalks

**C7A:** Business sponsored track mounted snow blowers

**C7B:** Provision of bike lane/landscape strip for storage

- Improved pedestrian safety and activities
- Improved lane utilization
- Maintenance costs
- May require loss of travel lane or right of way





C8: Pedestrian Crossings

**C8A:** Enhanced Crossings

**C8B:** Mid-block crossings


**C8C:** Pedestrian Signals/Flashers

- + Improved pedestrian safety and activities
- Inefficient pedestrian volumes




# Streetscape Improvements – Cross Section




# Aurora Avenue – Before (Shoreline, WA)






# **Aurora Avenue – After Construction**





  - Curb moving and undergrounding: approx. \$20 million






